Bruce Agee Connor, age 90, of Brookfield, passed away Friday, January 24, 2020, at his home with his wife Sharron, and his son Scott by his side.

He was united in marriage to Sharron Lee Schaefer on June 20, 1954 and they became the parents of Scott Connor and Kristi Lee (Connor) Malloy. He was an Engineer with the Burlington Railroad until his retirement in 1989. Bruce served as a deacon in the Freedom Baptist Church for many years and was a longtime member of the Brookfield VFW Post #4557. He loved to hunt and fish in his spare time.

Bruce is survived by his wife, two children, five grandchildren, two step-grandchildren, and five great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents Julius and Thelma, and one sister Lorella.
