



## Dillard Dale Standley

September 5, 1938 - November 23, 2024

Dale Standley, age 86, of Macon, Missouri, passed away at Samaritan Hospital on Saturday, November 23, 2024. He was surrounded by his wife of 66 years and his two daughters, Debbie and Julie.
