



Donald Eugene Riepe

February 19, 1935 - July 10, 2012

Donald Eugene Riepe, age 77, Brookfield, passed away Tuesday July 10, 2012 at Pershing Memorial Hospital.

Visitation will be held from 5 to 7 pm Friday, July 13, at the Evangelical United Methodist Church in Brookfield. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 a.m. Saturday, July 14 at the church with burial to follow at Rose Hill Cemetery. Don was born February 19, 1935 in Kansas City, MO, the son of Rex Vernon and Ella Heins Riepe. On March 24, 1956, he was united in marriage to Lucile Ann Smith in Brookfield. Don worked for the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad for 45 years as an engineer. He was a member of the United Transportation Union, and the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers.

Don is survived by his wife Lucile of Brookfield, three sons and their wives: Scott and Jan, Terry and Karin, and Todd and Jill, three grandchildren: Derek, Allison, and Brock, and two great-grandchildren: Briley and Reagan. Also surviving are numerous nieces, nephews, and other relatives.
