Elizabeth "Betty" Farrar, age 95, of Green Bay, WI; passed away Tuesday, February 7, 2023 in Green Bay WI.

Betty was born the daughter of John Henry and Louella (Berner) Moore on August 15, 1927 in St. Louis, MO. On June 6, 1949 Betty married William Harold Farrar Sr. in St. Louis, MO.
