



## Kenneth (Ken) Lee Walker

May 15, 1943 - January 29, 2025

Kenneth (Ken) Lee Walker, of Brookfield, passed away peacefully January 29, 2025, at 1:54 pm. He was surrounded by his family at the Livingston Manor Care Center in Chillicothe, MO.

Ken was born on May 15th, 1943, to Frank Meredith and Flossie Belle (King) Walker in Eugene, Oregon. Both parents preceded him in death. Ken was the youngest of six children and is survived by one brother, Frank Walker Jr. and sister-in-law, Elaine Walker. Ken met his loving wife, Leony Walker, through being “pen-pals”. They were united in marriage on March 13th, 1996 in Hong Kong. They were married for 29 years and to this union they had two children, Jonathan and Catherine (Kate) Walker.
