Randy taught his children many things that he was passionate about. How to raise show hogs was one of them and even won Reserve State Champion York Boar. He raised registry breeding livestock and later raised

USDA butcher hogs. Randy was a firm believer in fresh quality meat. He loved the Balloon Derby and for 13 years was on the chase crew for the Gumball Balloon. Randy worked for Orscheln Farm and Home in Brookfield for many years. Randy was a very loving son, husband, father, and grandfather. He was a kind man and will be dearly missed by his family and friends.
