



## Robert "Bob" LaVerne Rulon

July 15, 1934 - June 5, 2025

Robert "Bob" LaVerne Rulon, age 90, of Brookfield, MO; passed away Thursday morning, June 5, 2025, at Liberty Hospital in Liberty, MO.

Bob was born on July 15, 1934, to the late Hadley and Lois (Phillips) Rulon in New Boston, MO. Bob entered the United State Navy on November 9, 1953, in St. Louis, MO; and was honorably discharged on October 8, 1957 in Kingsville, TX. While in the service he was an airport control operator.

On October 25, 1959 he married Joyce Slaughter, and to this union they had two sons, Richard and Sidney. Bob served as a deacon at Pleasant Grove Church and Park Baptist Church, was a delegate for MFA, and was a board member on Yellow Creek Water Shed. He enjoyed putting together jigsaw puzzles, playing card games, and going to the coffee shops to visit with his friends.

Bob is survived by his wife, Joyce, of over 65 years; two sons, Richard (Julie) Rulon and Sidney (Meredith) Rulon; six grandchildren; fifteen great grandchildren; sister-in-law, Evelyn Rulon; and several other relatives.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Gary Rulon.
