Robert D. Hayes, 63, Brookfield, passed away Wednesday February 29, 2012 at Pioneer Skilled Nursing Center, Marceline.

Graveside memorial services will be held at 1:00 pm Friday March 09, 2012 at the Missouri State Veterans Cemetery, Jacksonville with Reverend Bob Seaman officiating.
