Scott Wohlgemuth, 81, of Mendon, MO; passed away Monday, May 18, 2026, at his home.

Scott was born on June 15, 1944, to the late Norman and LaVerna (Storm) Wohlgemuth in Kansas City, MO. Scott graduated from Bosworth High School with the class of 1962. After graduation he joined the United States Army, where he honorably served during the Vietnam era.
