



## Sharron Lee Connor

August 8, 1933 - November 6, 2022

Sharron Lee Connor, age 89, a lifelong resident of Brookfield, Missouri, passed away Sunday, November 6, 2022 at her home in Fruitland, Iowa surrounded by her family.

Sharron Lee was born a daughter of William and Lura (Pankey) Schaefer on August 8, 1933 in Kewanee, Illinois.

When Sharron was small her family moved from Kewanee, Illinois to the Pankey farm north of St. Catherine, Missouri. Sharron loved to ride ponies and horses. Sharron and her brother Conrad would ride the pony to school, Sharron would then tell the pony to go home and the pony would go back home where her father William would have the gate open waiting for the pony. Sharron was united into marriage to Bruce Agee Connor on June 20, 1954 at the Christian Church in Brookfield, Missouri. He preceded her in death on Friday, January 24, 2020.

Right out of high school Sharron was called by Frank Frantc to go to work at Missouri Power and Light Co. as a secretary, where she worked for 6 ½ years. Sharron then went to work at Brookfield Production Credit as a secretary for 6 years.

When Sharron adopted Scott in 1963 and Kristi in 1966, she quit work and became a stay at home mom. After school a lot of the kids would come to hang out at her house and she loved every minute of it.

Sharron was a member of the Freedom Baptist Church, Red Hat Club, and Sorority.

Sharron's hobbies were cutting articles out of the Brookfield paper about anything important and putting them in scrap books and there are a lot of them. She enjoyed visiting with friends at McDonald's and the Twin Parks. Sharron enjoyed playing card, word search, painting her outside furniture, going to the senior center for lunch, and taking care of her cats. Sharron especially enjoyed spending time with her grandkids and great grandkids.
